


# New/Transfer Student On-Campus Housing Confirmation Guide

#### RESIDENTIAL LIFE

- 1. To log onto Housing Self-Service, first, visit DataVU (datavu.valpo.edu).
- 2. On the homepage of the student menu of DataVU, you'll see the section labeled **Campus Services** and a sub-section labeled "**Housing and Meal Plans**" to access any housing applications available to you (pictured below).






3. You'll then be asked to **log in with your Valpo user information and password**. Once logged in, **click on the hyperlink** to log into Housing and Meal Plan Self-Service Portal.



4. Once your login information is confirmed, you'll be taken to your "Housing Self-Service Portal" homepage. Please make sure all the information on this page is correct.




5. As a new student, you will be asked for your personal contact information, emergency contact and forwarding address, and your living and building preferences in the **New Student On-Campus Housing Confirmation**. You can get started by clicking on "**Applications**" in the menu to the left (pictured below). You will then select the "**New Student On-Campus Housing Confirmation**" option (NOTE: be sure the **year** (highlighted in yellow below) is for the year you are applying for).



6. Application Step 1: Signing Your Housing Agreement/Contract


Once you are inside the Housing application, your first step will be to sign your Housing Agreement/Contract. It should look like this (see below). You should click on the "Please review the contract available here" option to review the agreement and cancellation terms. This is available on the Res Life website so you are welcome to review it there as well.

Once you have reviewed it, please type your name OR use a signature pad to sign your Housing Agreement/Contract. Then click **CONTINUE** at the bottom of the page.



### 7. Application Step 2: Your Personal Information and Living Preferences




#### 8. Application Step 3: Emergency/Parent Contact & Forwarding Address




#### 9. Application Step 4: Your Building/Room Type Preferences

Next, you'll then be able to make THREE living preferences (see below) as:

- All New Students will live in Brandt OR Alumni and will only have an option of a double room.
- **New Transfers** will live in Beacon, Guild Memorial OR Wehrenberg and will have an option of double, single, triple or quad rooms.

All of this information is also available to you on the screen to the right:




You can list each preference by Building/Hall by clicking **ADD** in the second section. Your preference will appear in the top box and can be deleted by clicking on the **TRASH CAN** to the right.

Please NOTE: just because all Halls/Room Types are listed does NOT mean they are available to you. Everything listed is an option depending on your class standing, semesters lived on campus AND the time of the year you are completing this application.

Be sure to select a Hall/Room Type for each number in the CHOICE box and then click ADD to the right and it will appear in the list above.

Click **CONTINUE** at the bottom of the page when you are done.



10. YOU ARE DONE! Once you click submit, you should see a confirmation screen that will let you know you were sent a confirmation email (Valpo student email). This email will tell you the next steps and what dates are important. Please be sure to review that information so you don't miss anything moving forward. Click OKAY and then HOME and you will be taken back to the Housing Self-Service Portal home page.
