Council of Deans Minutes of the Meeting of February 4, 1998

A. Dr. Michael Yohe spoke to the Council of the potential uses of the directory server. With the Data Tel system installed, it will be possible to export information (distribution lists, directories of employees, etc.) to the server. Should the campus directory be made available on the web? Issues: Privacy, especially for students, may be a concern but this can be handled by privacy flags where the person indicates what information he or she wants made public. The student directory should be Intranet and not Internet, otherwise the students will be subjected to commercial mail.

It was decided that anything available in the current printed campus directory should be made available on an on-campus web directory. On the Internet only abbreviated information should be made available, and people should have choice regarding what gets posted on the Internet

Data Tel will make it possible to have considerable administrative information available to students on the network but at the moment it is not clear or decided what sorts of information and how much should be made available.
