Minutes of the Meeting of February 2, 2000

1. Assistant Provost Bonnie Hunter consulted the Council regarding the appropriateness of casino boats recruiting on campus through the Career Center. It was decided that since these constitute a legitimate business, the University should not be excluding them. It is not the University's role to screen employers. The students should decide which employers will receive their resumes. We should inform the students that they may get calls from employers they do not desire, and they should exercise their own judgement.
