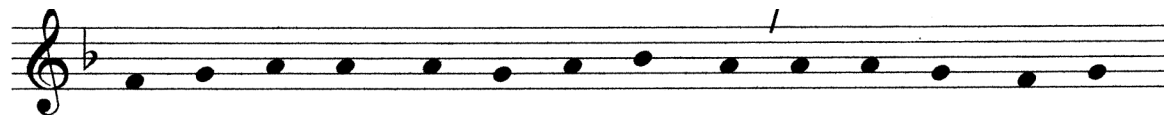
Prayer of the Day

Luther's Morning Prayer

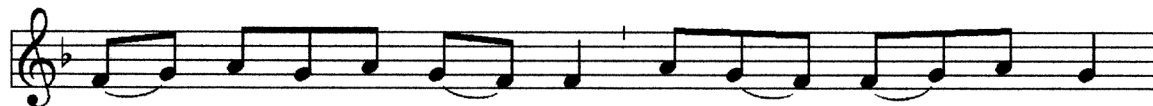
L Let us ask the blessing of God on our day.
